

Mission Trip Bolivia

April 2007



Purpose:

- To provide a cross-cultural trip in which students will see and experience how others live in God's world.
- To engage students in God's mission by using their gifts and abilities to share the love of Jesus in word and in compassionate service.

Trip Profile:

Mission Trip Bolivia is a short term mission trip designed to offer loving Christian service to Bolivian nationals and orphans. The mission team will interact and share with children at an orphanage/daycare. They will provide much needed help for various maintenance projects at local Christian Missions. They will also be prepared and willing to share testimonies, music or drama at local churches. While in Bolivia, the mission team will be able to enjoy a limited time to sight-see and experience the culture.

Location: Santa Cruz & surrounding area, Bolivia, South America

Timing: April 2007

Duration: 2 days pre-trip orientation + 21 days in-country

Cost: *\$2500 *Can.* (includes airfare, travel, meals, lodging, gift to host family, and love offering to orphanage/church)

**Successful applicants may receive up to 50% Short Term Mission Scholarship from the Academy.*

Application Requirements:

- Have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Minimum age - 16 years old by April 1, 2007
- Enrolled in *Anchor Academy's "World Missions 12"* course
- Able to earn or raise financial support
- Cooperative and willing to participate in all activities
