

Missions Fusion – Guatemala 2007

Purpose:

- To provide a short term mission trip that will blend cross-cultural studies, discipleship training and hands-on missions experience.
- To engage youth in God's mission by using their gifts and abilities to share the love of Jesus in word and in compassionate service.

Trip Profile:

Missions Fusion – Guatemala 2007 is an exciting short term mission trip designed to give youth a blended missions experience. This mission trip will offer B.C. high school credit courses – Cross Cultural Missions 12 & Discipleship 12, Spanish 11, Media Arts 11 - while living in Guatemala. Youth will participate in daily studies, discipleship training, evangelistic outreach and practical mission work amongst the Guatemalan people.

Location: Antigua & surrounding area, Guatemala

Timing: November 2007

Duration: 30 days in-country

Cost: *\$2750 CAD. Includes airfare, travel, meals, lodging, administration, course & teacher fees. Not included are costs for vaccinations, passports, & other pre-trip expenses. *For BC Students – international students will pay additional course costs. **Successful applicants may apply for Short Term Mission Scholarship/Bursary from Anchor Academy.**

Application Requirements:

- Have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- **Open to young people in grades 10, 11, & 12
- Enrolled in applicable mission courses at Anchor Academy
- Able to earn or raise financial support
- Cooperative and willing to participate in all activities

** Youth that are older than grades 10-12 may also apply and audit the courses. Each application will be considered on an individual basis and certain restrictions may apply.
